## PACKAGE DEALS

Gawler Aquatic Centre has 2 package deals to choose from. Payment must be made in full before Sunday 13 October 2019 to receive package deal. A parent or guardian of any child under the age of 3 years will receive an adult season pass.

- GOLD PACKAGE – Enrol into Term 4, Term 1 and SA Water VACSWIM and receive a FREE concession season pass AND a FREE week of Holiday Intensive program either in December or January school holidays, valued at \$617.00. Save \$250.00!
- SILVER PACKAGE – Enrol into Term 4 and Term 1 at the same time and receive a FREE concession season pass, valued at \$484. Save \$180!
- Concession season pass allows the student unlimited entry into the pool all season.


## BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS

- Enrolments open on Friday 23 August 2019.
- Lessons run in conjunction with the SA Public school term, excluding week 11 of Term 1 2020.
- The student/s may be withdrawn from the program if final payment is not made the day of lessons commencing.
- Our preferred method of communication is email. All changes to our terms and conditions, updates, promotions, and newsletters will be distributed via email. Please make sure we have your current email address.
- Customers are required to advise the Gawler Aquatic Centre Learn to Swim team of any medical conditions that students' may have. Providing this information is important, to ensure students' needs can be catered for and is critical in an emergency situation.
- Payments can be made over the phone via credit card or by cash. Due to the Aquatic Centre being closed, payments for Term 4 need to be made at the Gawler Sport and Community Centre Monday-Friday between 3:30pm-7:30pm until Sunday 6 October 2020.
- To secure your preferred class time all enrolments must be made within the early enrolment periods and are required to pay a \$40 non-refundable deposit per child.

## MAKE UP POLICY

- Make up lessons are only available due to illness with a valid doctors certificate or due to extenuating circumstances which need to be provided in writing to the Programs Coordinator.
- All make up lessons are subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed.
- Make up lessons can only be used in the term they are issued, no makeup lessons can be carried into another term.
- If the students make up class is missed, a replacement lesson will NOT be made available.

## SA WATER VACSWIM AND HOLIDAY INTENSIVES

- VACSWIM Fees are as follows for the 2020 program: Individual 

Participant fee	\$30.00pp
Location/Site/Pool entry Fee	\$4.50/day pp
Equipment Fee	\$1.50pp

- The family cap for SA Water VACSWIM is \$100 (4 or more children)
- The total fees per person must be paid in full on enrolment into the program. Time slots are not secured without full payment of the program fees.
- The \$40.00 deposit does not apply to SA Water VACSWIM and Holiday intensive programs full fees must be received to secure a spot into SA Water VACSWIM and Holiday intensive programs.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

- All Learn to Swim fees include admission of the Learn to Swim participant and spectators. If spectators wish to use the pool facility, they are required to pay the entry fee at the Kiosk.
- Due to public holidays, students enrolled on Mondays during Term 1 2020 will have a 8 week term and will be charged for a 8 week term.
- Family Discounts apply to families with three or more swim school participants. A 50% discount is applicable to the third (3rd) and consecutive participant. This does not apply to VACSWIM or Holiday programs.
- The Gawler Aquatic Centre Learn to Swim Program reserves the right to cancel or change classes and Swim Instructors if the need arises. If classes are to be cancelled due to inclement weather, families will be advised by Centre management and a suitable arrangement will be made.
- The Gawler Aquatic Centre has the right to cancel any class which becomes no longer viable, families will be given the option to move into another timeslot.
- Parents/Guardians are reminded that they are responsible for their children and must directly supervise them until their lesson has commenced and immediately after their lesson has finished.
- Gawler Aquatic Centre is a Watch Around Water (WAW) accredited facility and the WAW policy must be adhered to at all times.
- Parents are reminded to respect all other lesson participants' and avoid disrupting the class unless a child has an urgent medical/family issue that requires the child to be withdrawn from the water. Any questions or concerns whilst the lesson is being conducted are to be directed to the Swim School Supervisor/Coordinator.
- The Centre must be informed if a person entering the water has suffered from gastro/diarrhoea. In accordance to SA Health Regulations anyone who suffered from diarrhoea are not permitted in public pools for 14 days after the last diarrhoea episode.
- The use of electronic devices in change room areas is strictly prohibited. Any person requesting the use of an electronic device for photography or to film must agree and sign the electronic devices consent form available at the Kiosk. During this process the person will show a valid form of ID to a Gawler Aquatic Centre Staff Member and allow for their details to be recorded in our database.
- All children 3 and under are required to wear swim nappy at all times when they are in the water. This is to ensure patron safety and to maintain the highest possible water quality. Patrons will be asked to display evidence of a swim nappy at the pool entrance or at the start of their swimming lesson.
